

# Make A Meal

METRO HOMELESS YOUTH SERVICES

Support youth in our programs with a home-cooked or take-out meal! Youth are busy going to school, working, parenting, and creating plans towards stability and independence. Meals are greatly appreciated!

#### Meal Guidelines

- An in-kind donation form should be completed with an employee during drop off.
- Beverages, fresh fruit and/or dessert are optional but much appreciated!
- Meals should be completely prepared when dropped-off with only heating necessary.
- Meals should be dropped off by 4:30 p.m. if ready to eat OR by 2:30 p.m. if reheating is needed.
- Meals should serve eight adults. A complete meal includes a main dish, side dish and a vegetable. Please do not include pork products due to dietary restrictions.
- Disposable containers are preferred, or you can ask to have your food transferred into the services' dishes so you can take your containers with you.













#### Meal Ideas

Not sure what to make? No need to be extravagant — residents appreciate simple dishes (and please remember, no pork products). The residents' most common request? LOTS of flavor, seasoning, and spicy heat! Here are some meal ideas they like — but feel free to be creative!

- BBQ beef, BBQ chicken or Philly cheese steak sliders with corn on the cob and coleslaw.
- · Beef stew with biscuits or cornbread.
- Chicken or beef stir fry with rice and egg rolls.
- · Chili with biscuits or cornbread.
- Fried chicken with baked macaroni & cheese and greens.
- · Hamburgers, potato salad or chips and fruit.
- Homemade pizza, buffalo wings and salad.
- · Meatloaf with mashed potatoes, gravy and a vegetable.
- Spaghetti or lasagna with a meat sauce, salad and garlic bread.
- · Tacos or enchiladas with beans and Spanish rice.
- Take-out donations are also appreciated and make the youth feel special! Some ideas include KFC®, Popeyes, Chipotle, chinese food, pizza or sub sandwiches.
